The Squadron Adjutant or the Post Adjutant must maintain this document in the event there is an audit by IRS. The Post Adjutant must sign all Sons applications verifying that the member qualifies. In the event the Adjutant is not familiar with the new member, he should require a copy of the Veterans discharge papers.

Tips for Membership:

If the Veteran is living, he must be a member of The American Legion in order for his male descendants to join.

If the Veteran is deceased and was a member, his descendants can join under his eligibility.

If the Veteran is deceased and was not a member of The American Legion, then the Veterans discharge papers may be needed to verify if that Veteran did qualify to join the Legion.

There is no associate or auxiliary membership in the Sons of The American Legion.
